### Weighing of Grades/Class Rank

All subjects are given credit. Grades in academic classes which are labeled Honors, are given 1 extra quality point for a "C" or better. Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment college courses receive 2 extra quality points for any grade "C" or higher. Plus grades receive .5 quality points for the purposes of class rank only.

### Forgiveness Policy

Students who earn a "D", "F", or "I" in a class may elect to repeat that class in order to raise their GPA. Forgiveness for courses is limited to replacing a grade of "D", "F", or "I" with a grade of "C" or higher. The student's record will show all courses taken. The forgiveness rule can apply only one time per course.
